## When You're in a Conversation

1 Peter 3:15 reminds us to be prepared to give an answer—not to win an argument, but to share our hope.

Here are some simple prompts to help:

- “That’s a great question. Can I share how I see it from a Christian perspective?”
- “I may not have every answer, but I’ve found real hope in Jesus—want to hear why?”
- “What do you believe about that?” (Ask questions!)

## Core Biblical Reminders

- **2 Corinthians 5:20** – We are ambassadors for Christ.
- **Colossians 4:6** – Let your speech always be gracious.
- **Jude 1:3** – Contend for the faith with gentleness and truth.

## Quick Responses to Common Questions

- **Is there evidence for God?**
  - The design and order of the universe, objective morality, and the historical resurrection all point to a Creator.
- **Can we trust the Bible?**
  - Yes. It’s supported by manuscript evidence, archaeology, and fulfilled prophecy.
- **Why does God allow suffering?**
  - God doesn’t ignore suffering—He entered into it through Jesus, who suffered for our sake and offers hope through it.

You don’t need to know everything.

You just need to be ready with the hope you have.

The Holy Spirit does the heavy lifting—just show up, speak with love, and trust Him to work.
